Hudson County Community College is an award-winning, comprehensive urban college located just across the Hudson River from Manhattan in Jersey City and Union City, NJ. Fully accredited by Middle States Commission on Higher Education, the College offers courses and classes in a wide variety of disciplines to the people and businesses of Hudson County, one of the most historic and ethnically diverse areas of the United States. The College was recognized with the 2012 Association of Community College Trustees (ACCT) Northeast Regional Equity Award, was one of just five finalists in the U.S. for the American Association of Community Colleges' (AACC) Student Success Award, and was presented with the New Jersey Business & Industry Association's Good Neighbor Awards in 2009 for the Culinary Arts Conference Center and in 2012 for the North Hudson Campus Project, and in 2015 for the Library Building.

The College is currently searching for an Associate Dean of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM). Reporting to the Dean of Instruction, the Associate Dean of STEM supervises a faculty of approximately 20 full-time and 80 contingent instructors, oversees and directs the ongoing operation of the STEM division, ensures excellence of curriculum and instruction, and develops short and long-term strategic initiatives that support the College's mission. The successful candidate will demonstrate an understanding of the mission of an urban community college and be able to effectively lead an organization involving diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, and ethnic backgrounds. Candidates must have strong leadership and managerial skills, knowledge of trends in higher education and educational technology, and strong interpersonal and communication skills.

Requirements: A Master's Degree (a Ph.D is preferred) in a STEM field from a regionally accredited institution of higher education, as well as a minimum of three years of program management (preferably at the community college level) is required. Finalists will be required to submit official transcripts.
