**INSTRUCTOR OF ENGLISH**

Hudson County Community College is an award-winning, comprehensive urban college located just across the Hudson River from Manhattan in Jersey City and Union City, NJ. Fully accredited by Middle States Commission on Higher Education, the College offers courses and classes in a wide variety of disciplines to the people and businesses of Hudson County, one of the most historic and ethnically diverse areas of the United States. The College was recognized with the 2012 Association of Community College Trustees (ACCT) Northeast Regional Equity Award, was one of just five finalists in the U.S. for the American Association of Community Colleges' (AACC) Student Success Award, and was presented with the New Jersey Business & Industry Association's Good Neighbor Awards in 2009 for the Culinary Arts Conference Center and in 2012 for the North Hudson Campus Project, and in 2015 for the Library Building.

The College is currently searching for an Instructor English within the College's English and ESL Division. Under the supervision of the Associate Dean of English and ESL Division, the Instructor English is responsible for teaching 15 credits per semester of in English or other fields in which the faculty member is qualified, for example general humanities. The majority of the courses taught should be College Composition I and II. As a professional member of the College community, an instructor is also required to participate in division and college-wide activities such as curriculum development, academic advisement, committee work and/or other extracurricular activities. This is a full-time, ten-month, position.

The successful candidate will demonstrate an understanding of the mission of an urban community college and have experience working with a culturally diverse community, have demonstrable knowledge of pedagogical technology, strong interpersonal and communication skills, and demonstrated ability to provide diverse teaching methods to different learning styles. Must be able to teach students from diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, and ethnic backgrounds.

**Requirements:** Master's degree in Composition and Rhetoric, English, or closely related field, from a regionally accredited institution of higher education, as well as a minimum of three years of teaching experience (preferably at the community college level) is required. Finalists will be required to submit official transcripts and to provide a teaching demonstration. Experience in distance education desirable. Proficiency with various computer software programs and the use of Ellucian-Colleague or similar higher education platform preferred.
