



Biology and Chemistry Lab Technician

The College is currently searching for a full-time Laboratory Technician for biology and chemistry laboratories within the College's STEM Division. Under the general supervision of the Associate Dean of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics Division, the Biology/Chemistry Laboratory Technician is responsible for ensuring safe conditions for students and faculty to carry out laboratory experiments, setting up and maintaining laboratories, cleaning instruments and equipment, keeping appropriate inventory of laboratory materials and equipment, providing technical assistance and support to students and faculty during laboratory works, solving operational issues occurring during laboratory sessions, and purchasing laboratory supplies and equipment. This is a full-time, twelve-month position.

The successful candidate should have an understanding of the mission of an urban community college, possess an experience working with a culturally diverse community, and project a positive self-image of professionalism. and demonstrate strong interpersonal and communication skills at all times.

Requirements: Associate Degree in Biology, Chemistry or a closely related field, from a regionally accredited institution of higher education, as well as a minimum of one year of related work experience, preferably at the college level, is required. A Bachelor's Degree is preferred.
