The College is looking for a full-time Instructor for Academic Foundations Mathematics (10 month tenure track, Instructor rank). Full-time faculty teach 15 credits/contact hours per semester of day and evening classes, maintain office hours, provide advisement for students, participate in curriculum development and review, assist in assessment activities, and participate in College and professional development activities. Must be able to teach at all campus locations. Finalists will be required to submit official transcripts and to provide a teaching demonstration. The successful candidate will demonstrate an understanding of, and commitment to the role of a comprehensive community college in an urban, multi-cultural setting.

Position Requirements:

Master's degree in Mathematics and a minimum of 2-3 years of college-level teaching experience, preferably at the community college level, are required. Knowledge of modern technology and its use in the classroom, strong interpersonal and communication skills, and ability to provide diverse teaching methods to different learning styles are necessary for this position. Applicants must be able to teach students from different academic, socioeconomic, cultural, and ethnic backgrounds. Experience in distance education, proficiency in various computer software programs, and the use of Ellucian/Colleague are preferred.
