The College is currently searching for a full-time tenure track Instructor in Exercise Science for the Division of Nursing and Health Sciences. Reporting to the Associate Dean for Nursing and Health Sciences, the Instructor will teach a minimum of 15 credit hours per semester, developing lab exercises and coordinating lab sections as appropriate, participating in division activities such as curriculum development and academic advisement, and contributing to the College community through committee work and other extracurricular activities. Full-time faculty members are expected to engage with the College's student success initiatives.

Required: Master's degree in Exercise Science, Athletic Training or closely related field from a regionally accredited institution of higher education. Must be a certified personal trainer (NASM preferred). Experience teaching in the discipline preferred. Demonstrated knowledge of modern technology and its use in the classroom. Strong interpersonal and communication skills. Demonstrated ability to provide diverse teaching methods and learning styles. Demonstrated excellence in teaching or group training and the ability to teach students from diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural and ethnic backgrounds. Experience teaching in the discipline and online learning and proficiency with various software programs preferred.
