

Instructor – Medical Assisting (Full-time - Tenure Track)

The College is currently searching for a **full-time tenure track Instructor in Medical Assisting for the Nursing and Health Sciences Division**. Reporting to the Associate Dean for Nursing & Health Sciences. The instructor will teach a minimum of 15 credit hours per semester, assist in the coordination of classes and schedules of adjunct instructors, assist in assessment of courses and programs, and other assigned duties. Candidate must have medical assisting experience in areas of clinical office procedures (EKG/Phlebotomy), Pharmacology, and Pathophysiology.

QUALIFICATIONS: Minimum of a Master's degree in Medical / Health Science or closely related field from a regionally accredited institution of higher education, as well as a minimum of three years of work in the field. National Certification as a Medical Assistant. The successful candidate will demonstrate an understanding of the mission of an urban community college and have experience working with a culturally diverse community. Knowledge of pedagogical technology, strong interpersonal and communication skills. Demonstrated ability to provide diverse teaching methods to different learning styles. Must be able to teach students from diverse academic, socioeconomic, cultural, and ethnic backgrounds. **Finalists will be required to submit official transcripts** and to provide a teaching demonstration. **PREFERRED**: Proficiency with various computer software programs and the use of Ellucian-Colleague or similar higher education platform. 1-3 years of college-level teaching is preferred for all full-time lecturers at HCCC.
