Comments from the Public: There were no comments from the public.

Awards, Recognitions and Special Reports:

- 1. Veronica Gerosimo, Director of Student Activities, and Angline Plummer, Past President of HCCC Chapter of The National Society of Leadership and Success (NSLS), addressed the Board and presented the College with the Order of Sigma award, conferred by NSLS for their achievement in completion of all ten pillars in the society's Pillar Program, which set standards of best practices in running a chapter. For the Spring 2017 semester, only 27 of the 549 NSLS chapters nationwide achieved this honor.
- 2. President Gabert congratulated Trustee Lee on the birth of his daughter and attorney John Geppert on the birth of his granddaughter.
