**WHEREAS**, notwithstanding that the Services constitute a professional service pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-25.5 (a)(1) and may be negotiated and awarded directly by the College, the College publicly advertised a Request for Proposal ("RFP") for the Services for a term not to exceed one (1) year; and,

WHEREAS, the College solicited proposals from qualified vendors using a fair-and-open-process; and,

**WHEREAS**, the College received one (1) proposal in response to the solicitation from Connell Foley LLP ("CF") at a rate of \$200 per hour; and,

**WHEREAS**, the College has determined that the cost proposal from CF is responsive and reasonable as to price; and,

WHEREAS, the cost of the Services will be funded from the operating budget; and,

**WHEREAS,** the Administration, Finance Committee, and Capital Projects Advisory Committee recommend these services;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Trustees of Hudson County Community College award a contract for Real Estate Legal Counsel Services to Connell Foley LLP of Jersey City, New Jersey, in accordance with the terms of the proposal submitted by the law firm.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Trustees authorize the Administration to take all steps necessary to effectuate the terms of this resolution.

WHEREAS, the College received two (2) proposals in response to the advertised RFP:

WHEREAS, the cost of the Services shall be funded from the operating budget; and,

**WHEREAS,** the Administration, Finance Committee, and Capital Projects Advisory Committee recommend the award of contract for the Services:
