Their courage motivated me to apply for my first TEDx talk, aiming to break the stigma surrounding mental illness among college students. I am proud to share that my talk, delivered this past April, is now in the top 1% of all TEDx talks in terms of engagement and inspiration.

From day one, I strive to be humble and transparent about my journey—from community college to my current role as an educator. I teach an evening class from 6 to 9:30 PM, and often keep the Zoom meeting open afterward because students want to keep connecting and bonding. This has cultivated a close-knit atmosphere where diversity in age, major, and ethnicity thrives. I take great pride in creating a safe space that empowers all of us to become stronger and more resilient communicators.

Having traveled to 124 countries and navigated my own mental health challenges, I leverage my experiences to uplift and inspire my students. If necessary, I am confident that both my former and current students would be willing to share their experiences and growth as part of this nomination. In previous institutions, I was honored by the National Communication Association for Exemplary Teaching and named Professor of the Year at St. John's University.
