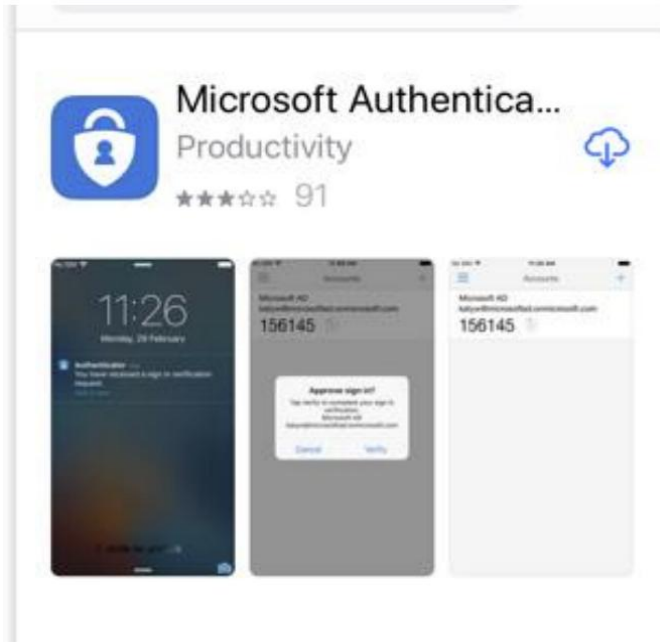

If the app displays a six-digit code, choose "Next".

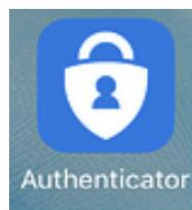
Step 6:

- **On your phone's App Store, search for Microsoft Authenticator app and download it.**



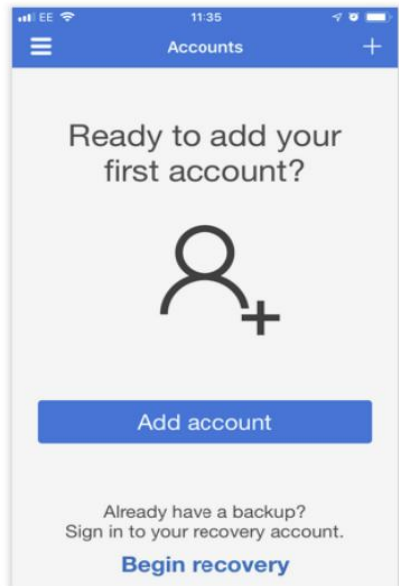
Step 7:

- **You will now see the app called Authenticator on your phone.**



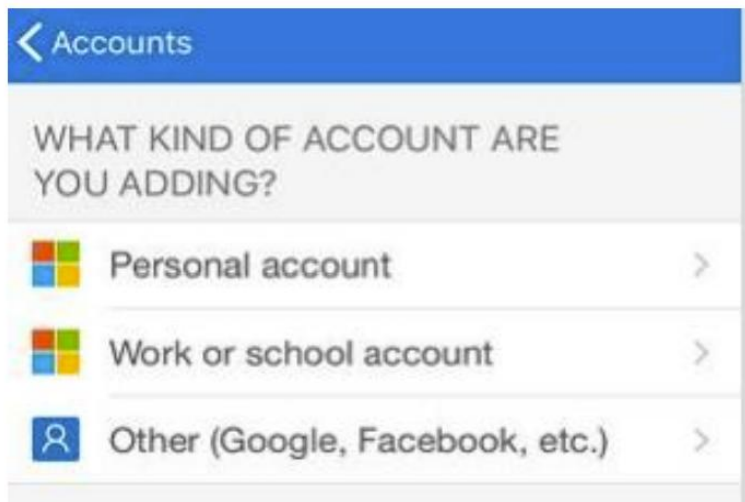
Step 8:

- **Skip any Intro screens the app may present until you get to the Ready to add your first account? Screen.**

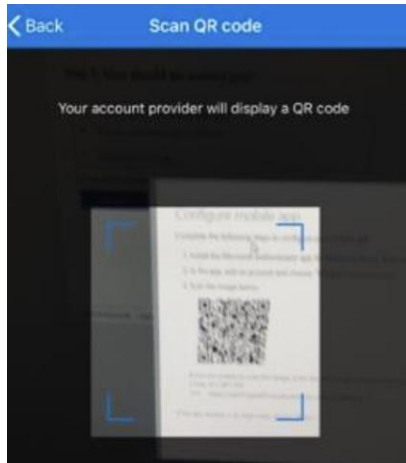


Step 9:

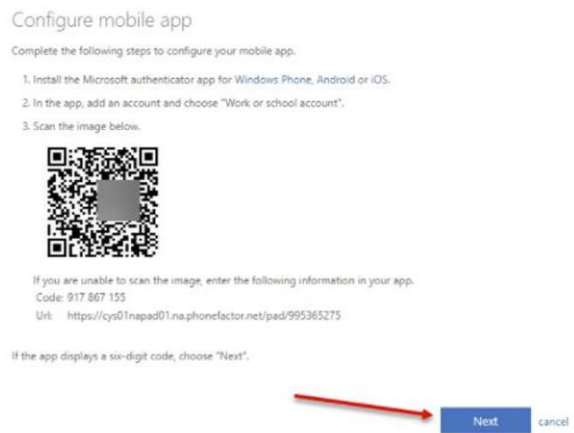
- **Click on Add Account and then Select work or school account.**



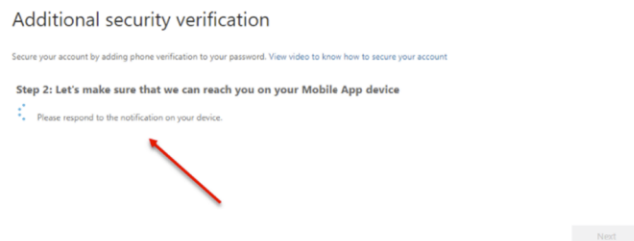
Step 10: • Your phone will prompt to allow use of camera. Click Allow and then point your camera at the QR code on your screen.



Step 11: • On your screen, click on Next.



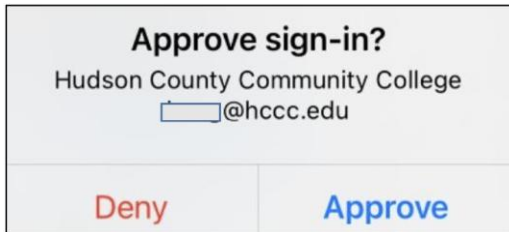
Step 12: • The message “please respond to the notification on your device”. Check your phone for a new notification of the authenticator app.



Step 13: • Click on the notification.



Step 14: • Unlock your phone and click Approve.



Step 15: • Enter your phone number. This is in case you lose access to your mobile app and then click Next.
