On-Campus :

Class sessions meet at a specific location on specified day(s) and times throughout the semester.

Online :

Course content is delivered online in Canvas. There are no scheduled meeting times and students have flexibility in completing work within each weekly unit. (Location will be "Online" and "ON" in the section code.)

Remote :

Class sessions meet via a videoconferencing tool such as WebEx on specified day(s) and times throughout the semester.

Hybrid (On-Campus/Online) :

The majority of course content is delivered online in Canvas and students have flexibility in completing work within each weekly unit. Lab/lecture sessions meet at a specific location on specified day(s) and times throughout the semester.

Hybrid (Remote/Online) :

The majority of course content is delivered online in Canvas and students have flexibility in completing work within each weekly unit. Lab/lecture sessions meet through a videoconferencing tool such as WebEx on specified day(s) and times throughout the semester.

Immersive Telepresence Video (ITV) :

Class sessions meet at multiple locations on specified day(s) and times throughout the semester. Specialized technology is used to connect multiple locations through audio and video.

Can I log in to my account immediately after I apply?

Yes. Once you apply and are accepted to HCCC you will receive an email with instructions on your Username and Password to access the MyHudson student portal. Instructions will be sent to the email address you entered in your application to HCCC. Be sure to check your spam folder if you haven't received this email within 24 hours of your application.


