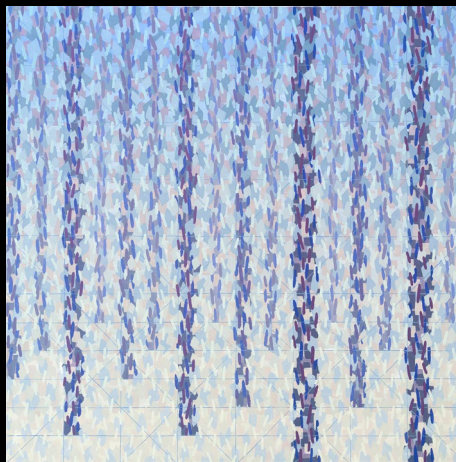


Robe of Resilience **by Lisa Ficarelli Halpern**

Resilience is defined as the ability to withstand and recover from adversity; it represents toughness and flexibility that is both a physical and mental state. The motifs in the printed design describing global events witnessed and endured are embedded within a Rococo inspired repeating pattern. The fabric chosen for the silkscreen print is dyed in the vibrant fuchsia 2022 Color of the Year, which serves to support the commemorative nature of the design and a “feminine” theme, since pink is traditionally associated with gender specific women and girls.

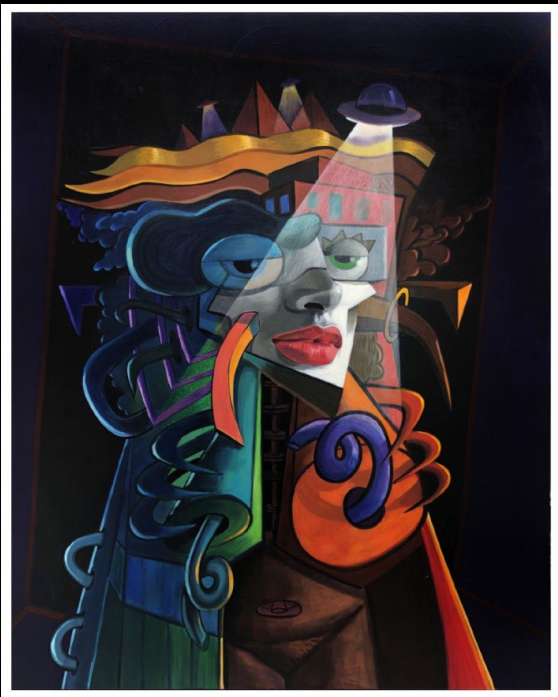

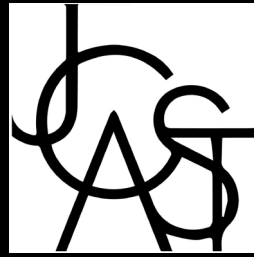
**Geometric Giggles by Ray Arcadio
