Earning qualifying scores on prior learning assessments such as College Board's College Level Examination Program (CLEP) and NYU's Language Proficiency **Exams can help you save time and money on your way to a degree by earning credit for what you already know.**

CLEP and NYU Language Proficiency exams test mastery of college-level material acquired in a variety of ways — through general academic instructions, significant independent study or extracurricular work.

## **Who earns college credit with prior learning assessments?**

- High School/ Home-schooled students
- Adult students/Professionals
- Military service members
- Students fluent in other languages
- International students

HCCC students may be awarded up to 30 credits toward a degree and 15 credits toward a certificate for the prior education experience in several ways: Transfer Credit, CLEP, Advanced Placement, NYU Foreign Language Proficiency Tests, Work/Life Portfolio Assessment, Military courses, and Credit by Examination. The College does not guarantee the transferability to other institutions of credit earned in these ways.
