Once any construction project is conceived it has to go through different phases like environmental studies, traffic impact studies, legal approvals, contract negotiations, designing, bidding, execution, etc. Through a partnership with the National Science Foundation and NJ Pathways to Career Opportunities, these workshops expose students to not only all phases of a construction project, but also the roles of different professionals involved in a project like legal teams, architects, engineers, technicians, safety and security personnel, traffic diversion teams, etc. These workshops are a great gateway to HCCC's Construction Management AAS program and rewarding careers in the construction industry.

## What to Expect:

- The workshops will be conducted REMOTELY.
- Lectures will be in an interactive style classroom discussion. All the course and study material will be provided to students.
- After every session, students will be given small assignments related to the topics discussed in the class. Students will do some background research on these topics and prepare small reports.
