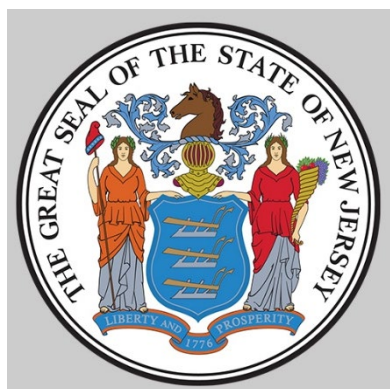


College Readiness Now (CRN) Profile for the 2019 – 2023 Years
