DEFINITIONS:

Credentialed Instructors:

High school teachers that have met the respective department's requirements to serve as a HCCC instructor and teach a dual course for students to potentially earn both high school and college credits.

Dual Courses:

Courses taught by a credentialed high school instructor on the grounds of the high school.

On-Grounds:

Courses taught in person at one of HCCC's campuses or satellite location (Journal Square, North Hudson Campus, Secaucus Center) during specified meeting days and times.

Online:

Courses taught online asynchronously (distance learning), without any specified meeting days and times.

Remote:

Courses taught online synchronously (distance learning), during specified meeting days and times.

Success Rate:

Completion of the course with a passing grade (C–, C+, B–, B, B+, A–, A).
