

Importing a Course from the Canvas Commons

The Canvas Commons is a repository of Canvas course content created by Canvas to facilitate sharing of modules, assignments, and even entire courses.

How to import a course from the Commons

- Log in to Canvas
- On the green Canvas Menu Bar that runs down the left side, click the Commons button (see figure below.)



- On the Commons landing page, enter a search phrase to filter the list of items.
- Click the matching item

*Note: If you have used that template before, you may be asked if you want to update your courses—generally, you should **dismiss** that prompt.*

- Click the **Import/Download** button (located on the right side of the screen.)



- You will then see a list of your **current courses**
- Select one (or several) of your target courses, then click the **Import/Download** button.
 - **Caution! Don't select any online or hybrid courses since they already have their content loaded!**
- Next, click **Import into Course** (**Don't click Download!**)



- Navigate to your Canvas course
 - It will take a few minutes to import – click Refresh occasionally to monitor progress.
- Once the import is done, go ahead and modify your course.
