Montclair State University will accept a total of 70 credits from the AS program in Nursing at HCCC. An additional 12-15 credits can be transferred from HCCC so that a total of 85 credits can be transferred to MSU. Students may elect to complete some or all of the additional 12-15 credits at HCCC or MSU. Thirty-five credits of upper division nursing major courses must be completed at MSU to have the BSN degree conferred by MSU (120 credits required).
