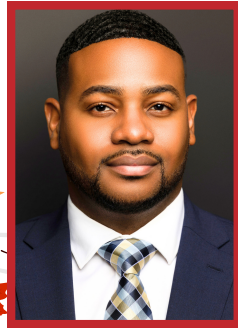


MEET THE TEAM

What is one piece of advice or a motto that guides you in your professional journey?

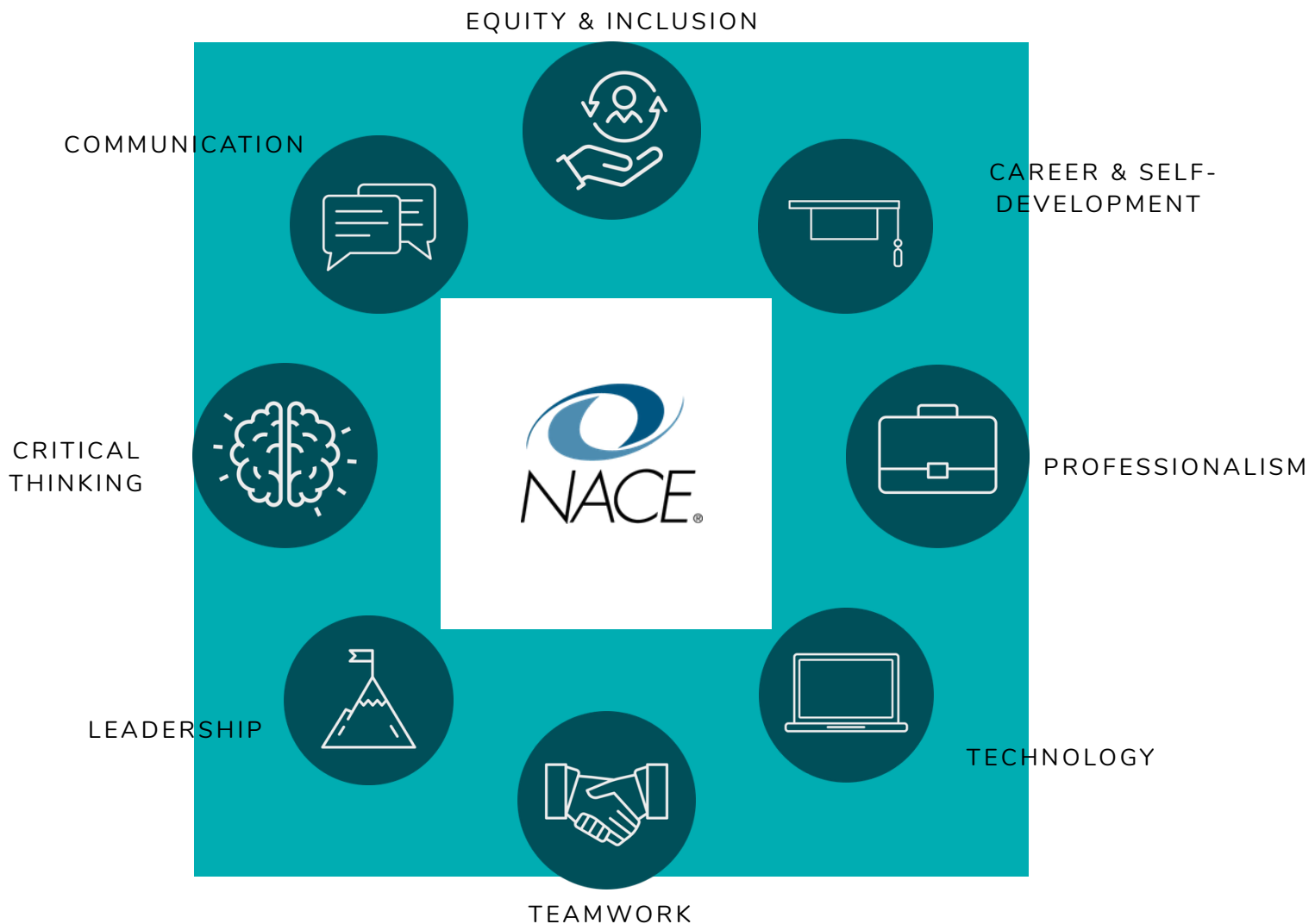

NATIONAL TRANSFER STUDENT WEEK

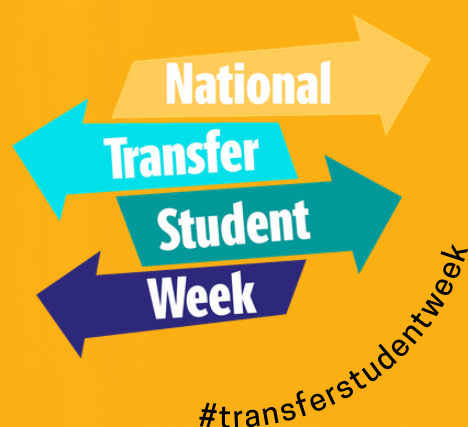

Internships & Apprenticeships: Opportunities to Explore

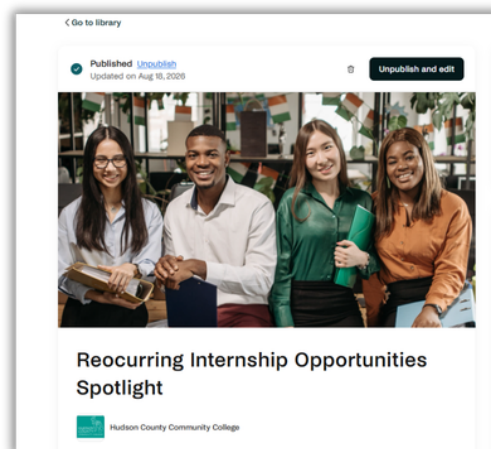
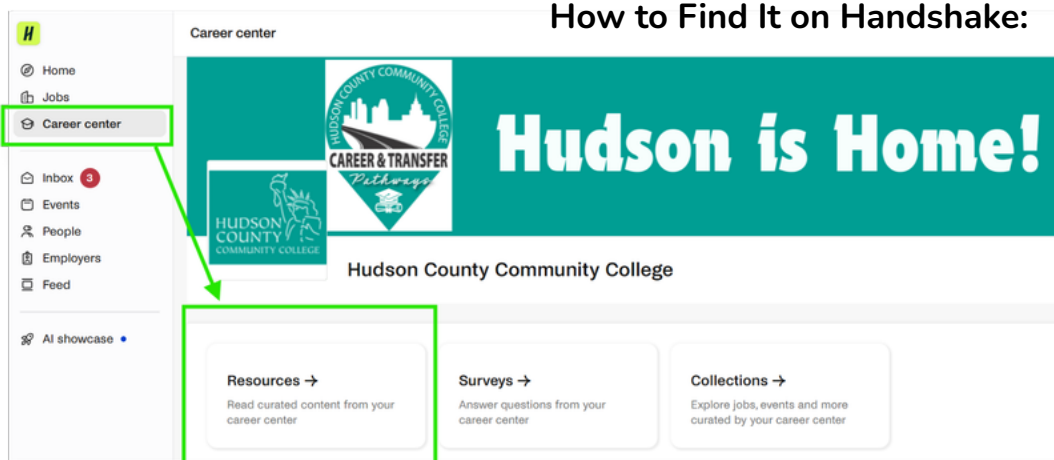
Looking for an internship or apprenticeship to gain hands-on experience and prepare for your future career?

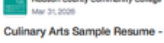
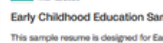
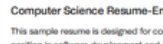
